

Essential requirements

Any offer of a place to train to teach with PLSCITT/ELIP will be subject to meeting the following requirements:

Safeguarding

We are a safer recruitment provider and are committed to safeguarding children. A satisfactory Enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check is a requirement of joining the Training Programme and being employed in a school. The DBS check will be completed ahead of starting the programme.

We also complete checks of relevant suspension and prohibited lists. If you are successful in being made a conditional offer, we will ask you to disclose any information that would subsequently be made known to us through the DBS process, and/or other disclosures that are relevant to be investigated as part of our safeguarding responsibilities.

References

References will be verified and any issues will be clarified with referee and/or candidate. Content confirmed with the referee and electronic references are verified as from a legitimate source.

Qualifications

You'll need to hold an undergraduate degree (ideally 2:2 or above) awarded by a UK higher education provider, or a recognised equivalent qualification.

You'll need to have achieved or be working towards a standard equivalent to grade C/4, or above, in the GCSE examinations in mathematics.

You'll need to have achieved or be working towards a standard equivalent to grade C/4, or above, in the GCSE examinations in English. Please note that we will accept a minimum of grade C/4 GCSE in English Language.

All trainee teachers applying for the primary programme must also have achieved or be working towards a standard equivalent to a grade C/4, or above, in a GCSE science dual award examination.

You will be asked to provide original certificates or diplomas for all the academic or vocational qualifications required for the post, plus any that are relevant to the post.

Health Check

You will also be required to complete a health check to assess if you are fit to teach.
